



## NASAR Instructor Trainer/Instructor Application

**Individuals interested in applying for NASAR Instructor Trainer/Instructor positions shall submit the attached application and all documentation listed to the Education Services Director at National Association for Search and Rescue, [education@nasar.org](mailto:education@nasar.org). Incomplete application packets will not be accepted.**

**Any applicant that does not meet the requirements specified will be notified by the Education Services Director and must reapply once they have met the requirements.**

### **The Instructor Trainer Applicant:**

- Submit Instructor/Instructor Trainer application.
- Meet the requirements to be an Instructor.
- Taught course a minimum of 3 times or approval of AHJ or Sponsoring Agency.

### **The Instructor Applicant:**

- Submit Instructor/Instructor Trainer application.
- Pass the course at the Instructor Level that he/she would like to instruct or an approved equivalent.
- Submit letter of recommendation from the candidate's Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ), Public Safety agency, Institution of Higher Learning or Non-Governmental Search and Rescue Team/Unit. Non-Governmental Teams/Units must provide copy of MOU with AHJ or Sponsoring Agency. Letters must be on official letterhead and signed by a legally authorized representative (LAR). (Definition of LAR: any individual person, judicial body or other body of individuals who are authorized under state and/or federal law to act as a representative of their agency).
- Submit resume of candidate indicating experience in search and rescue or related field and instructional experience.
- Submit signed background check form with fees or affidavit.
- Attend an Instructor Workshop or equivalent.

### **Equivalency Process**

For a course to be considered equivalent to a NASAR Course it must be conducted by a Federal/State or local jurisdiction or recognized professional organization. Submit the following:

- Who owns the course
- Course Name
- Course Description
- Course Syllabus
- Testing Methodology
