What to bring: The workshop will take place in a classroom (no field module) so there are no special logistical requirements.  
Summary: A recently completed data project collected 17,000 cases of missing person searches from around the world. This two-day workshop will teach participants several new methods of looking at missing person searches based upon lost person behavior. Several new profiles will be presented including ATV, snowmobiles, mushroom pickers, autism, and others. Emphasis will also be placed on Alzheimer's, despondent, psychotic, mental retardation, abduction cases, and urban cases. Extensive use of case studies and map problems will allow the participants to work through dozens of scenarios.
