Certification Documentation Checklist

All required documents **MUST** be supplied prior to written test or field test will be administered.
Documents supplied with registration are appreciated but can be provided the day of test.

Do not include original certifications as they will not be returned, please submit copies.

CST3 REQUIREMENTS:

- Canine **must** be a minimum of 12 months of age
- Copy of current NASAR Membership Card (must be provided to receive member rate)
- Incident Command System (ICS)/Incident Management System (IMS) course NIMS ICS-200, modules 1-6 or higher level course.
- IS-700 NIMS Integration. (<http://training.fema.gov/EMIWeb/IS/is700.asp>)
- A current nationally approved CPR certification.
- American Red Cross or equivalent Basic First Aid Course or higher medical training.
- NASAR Search and Rescue Technician II.
- NFPA 472/CFR 291910.120 Part Q - Hazardous Materials – Awareness Level Course.
- Present proof that their canine has passed an AKC Canine Good Citizenship or equivalent.
- The candidate must have completed a Bloodborne Pathogens training course that meets or exceeds 29CFR1910. This course must have been taught by a person who meets the requirements as shown in 29CFR1910.
- Successful completion of a Crime Scene Preservation Class taught by a State or POST certified law enforcement instructor.
- Proof of passing the Canine SARTECH(tm) written examination, if applicable.

CST2 REQUIREMENTS:

- Same as CST3

OR

- Canine SARTECH III Certificate (or challenge – see Canine SARTECH III Area only)

CST1 REQUIREMENTS:

- NASAR Canine SARTECH II (in discipline)
